City Overview:



Aviodora is a vibrant city divided into three main districts, a mystical forest and an airport:

1. Plumsterdam
2. Simffeil

3. Simtorini
4. Mystical Forest
5. Aviodora International Airport

Each district offers unique attractions, accommodations, and activities for Sims.

Plumsterdam



Inspired by Amsterdam, Plumsterdam features iconic canals, bustling markets, and rich history.

Accommodations

1. Hostel on Canal Street:
 - Budget-friendly with shared amenities.
2. Room Studio on Red Light Street:
 - Compact yet cozy, located near nightlife hotspots.

Shopping

Available Stores (Rabbithole):

- Gnomes
- DIY supplies
- Knits
- Collections
- Bikes

- **Wedding-related items**

Activities

- **Coffee Shop (Open Venue):** A cozy space to enjoy treats and drinks.
- **Tulip Fields (Open Venue):** Admire vibrant flowers or have a picnic near the windmill.
- **Playgrounds**
- **Basketball Court**
- **Picnic Park:** Enjoy a romantic picnic while spotting the old train scheduled to arrive every 3 hours!



- **Red Light Street:**

Tooltips display price ranges and opening hours.

- **Strip Club (Rabbithole):** Sims can enjoy performances
- **Woohoo with the Grim Reaper:** May temporarily transform Sims into ghosts!
- **Woohoo with Ghosts, Werewolves, Sims (for 1 or 2 hours), or Stars (Be cautious! Woohooing with a star might result in scandals and Sims getting doxxed, leading to prank calls and texts.)**
- **Ruins of the First Red House:** Explore historical remnants.
- **Casino:** Purchase chips and try your luck with different machines.
- **Red Light Museum:** Learn about the district's history.
- **WooHoo Museum:** Test your skills on the WooHoo Simulator and earn a Certificate (only 5 in 100 Sims can achieve this).

- **Street Performers:** Tip for live entertainment.
- **Red Azure Escape:** A hideout for Sims where they can sleep at night

Simffeil



Known for its elegance, Simffeil combines cultural landmarks with fun activities.

Accommodations

1. Art Déco Hotel:

- **Four luxury-themed rooms, each offering unique amenities.**
- **Includes wellness access and continental breakfast at the partner DIY restaurant on Landgraab Street.**
- **Check-in by clicking on the doors to see if room is available**

Activities

- **Simffeil Tower & Arch Dé Plémbob:** Take selfies or propose to loved ones under these iconic landmarks.
- **Simffeil Plaza (rabbithole):** Shop for clothing, books, toys, medicine, decorations and more.
- **Chocoplumb Confectionary (not wallet-friendly, rabbithole):** purchase sweets, bread, muffins and more!
 - **Breaking Into Chocoplumb:** Try breaking into the confectionary at night but beware of the police (rabbithole).
- **Canvas Art Studio (rabbithole):** Take painting classes or buy supplies

- **Aviodora Dream Cone (rabbithole):** Buy ice creams.
- **Cinema:** Two movie rooms (public or private) available—tickets can be purchased via phone or in person.
- **Library:** Relax and read or bring kids for educational activities.
- **Aquarium on Marine Street:** Marvel at the fish, jellyfish, and sharks.
- **Arcade:** Play with games
- **Needs Habitat (rabbithole):** A quick pit stop to refill needs like hunger, hygiene, and energy.
- **Gym:** Purchase memberships for fitness or wellness-focused Sims.
- **White Smoke Hookah Lounge:** Hang out in a chill environment.
- **Ye Ol' Bar:** Play foosball and enjoy old-school vibes.
- **Goth Botanique:** A serene botanical garden perfect for relaxing.
- **Post Office (rabbithole):** Apply for university, pay bills, send packages including prank boxes or postcards.
- **City Hall:** Adopt animals, look for odd jobs, do volunteer events, buy businesses, change phone number (in case of doxxing), apply for passport, or birth certificate copy or start a name change process.
- **Clothing Store:** buy and browse clothes

Simtorini



The smallest district, inspired by Santorini, Simtorini offers serene beauty and unique attractions.

Accommodations

1. **Airbnb:** Features a private terrace and hot tub for romantic getaways.

Activities

- **Water Playground (Requires Growing Together):** Family-friendly fun with slides and splash zones.
- **Outdoor Wellness Cinema:** Watch movies in a tranquil outdoor setting in a hot tub.
- **Seasonal Museum Exhibits:** Rotating art and history displays.
- **Old Bells (Requires Life & Death):** Functional bells that offer unique gameplay interactions.
- **Sunset Valley:** Perfect for admiring picturesque views and sunsets.
- **Tourist Center:** Purchase City Cards and access detailed guides to the district.
- **Bubble Tea Shop (Requires High School Years):** Enjoy trendy drinks and snacks.
- **Waterfall WooHoo Spot (Requires Island Living):** A romantic hidden location.
- **Grocery Store:** Purchase everyday needs.
- **Farm Shop (rabbithole):** Buy anything related to farm life.
- **Theater (rabbithole):** Watch the Phantom of the Plumbob play.
- **Gas Station (rabbithole):** Use the bathroom or buy groceries, open 24/7

Mystical Forest

An enigmatic area for adventurous Sims.

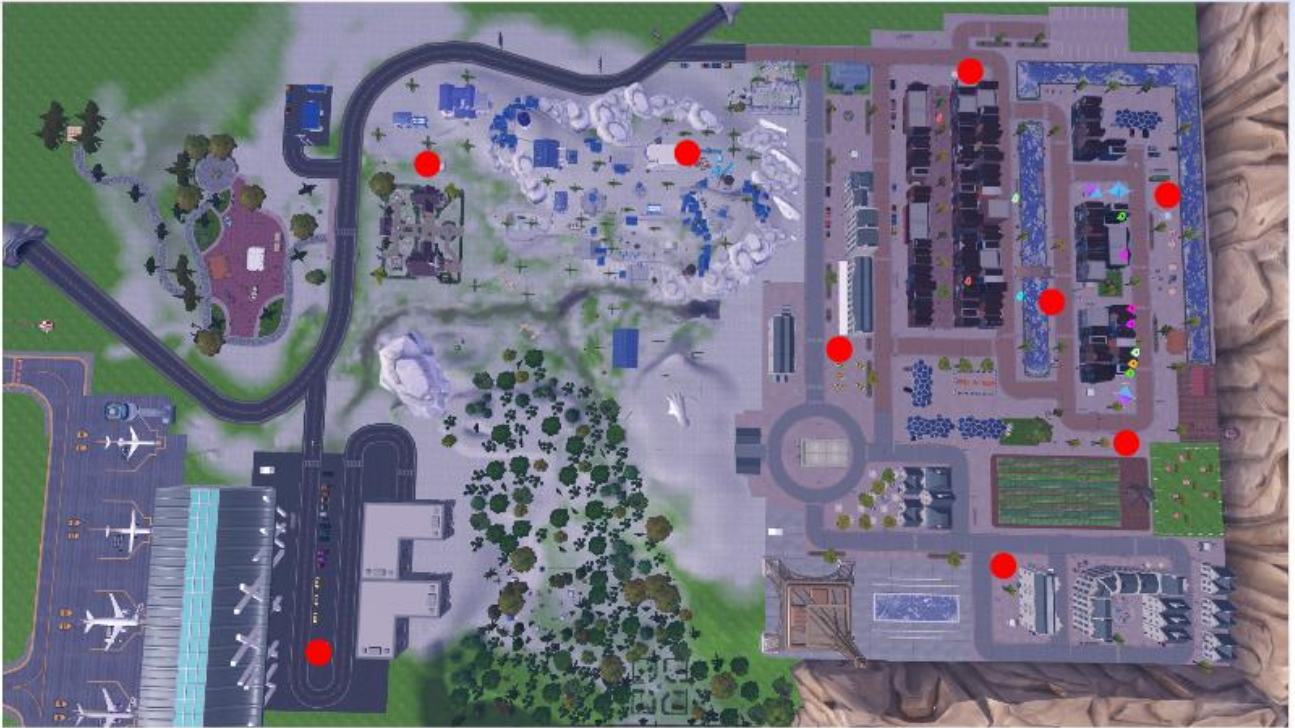
Activities

- **Camping:** Set up tents and explore the forest.
- **Graveyard Decoration:** Pay respects or add personal touches.
- **Vampire Hideout:** Discover hidden vampire lore.

Misc or Citywide:

- **Unknown Place: Mystery Fountain** (drink red nectar for free as many times as you want after finding the fountain)
- **Bike Rental:** rent bikes accross the city

Bike Racks



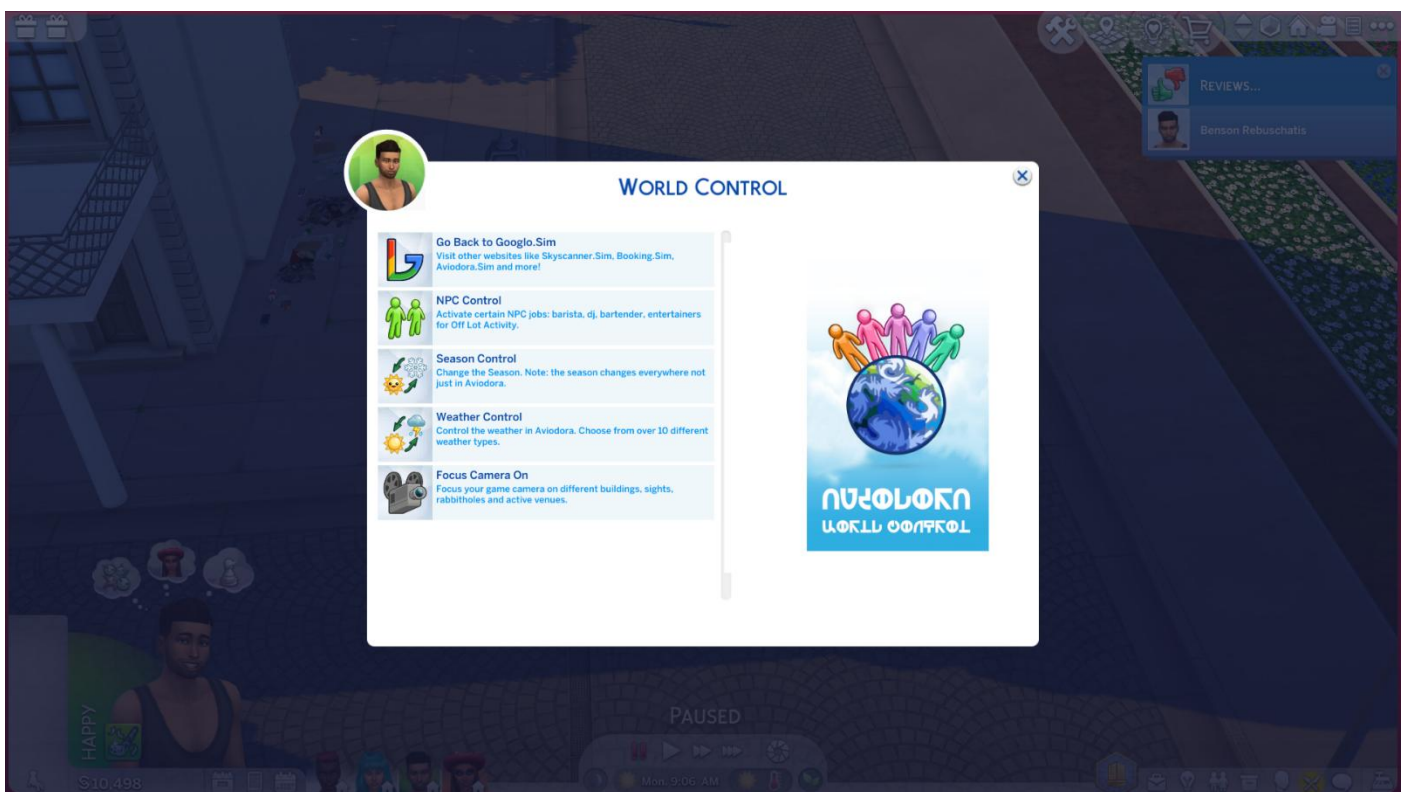
The red dots on the map symbolize the bike rental points, where Sims can rent or return bikes across Aviodora.

Menus

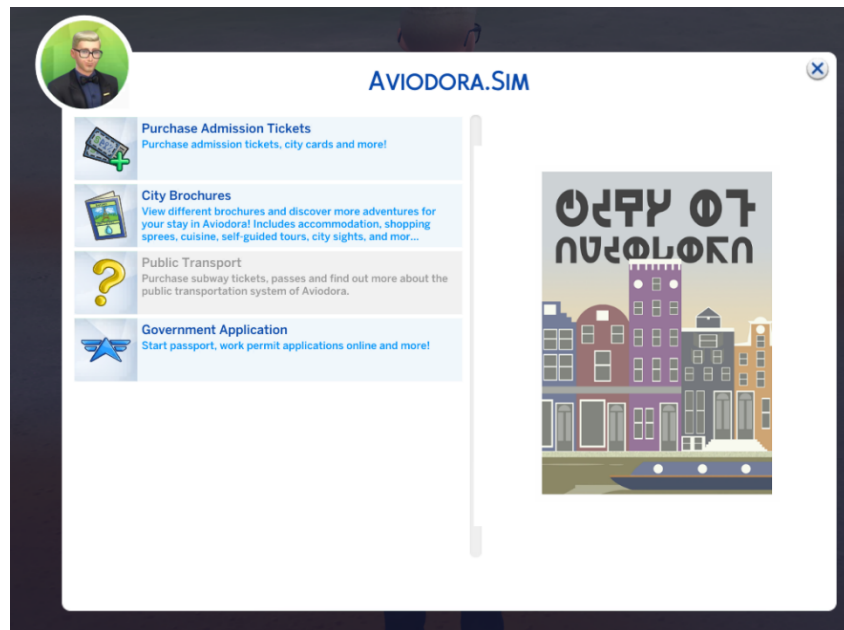
1. **World Control:** Activate NPCs like bartenders, DJs, and entertainers.



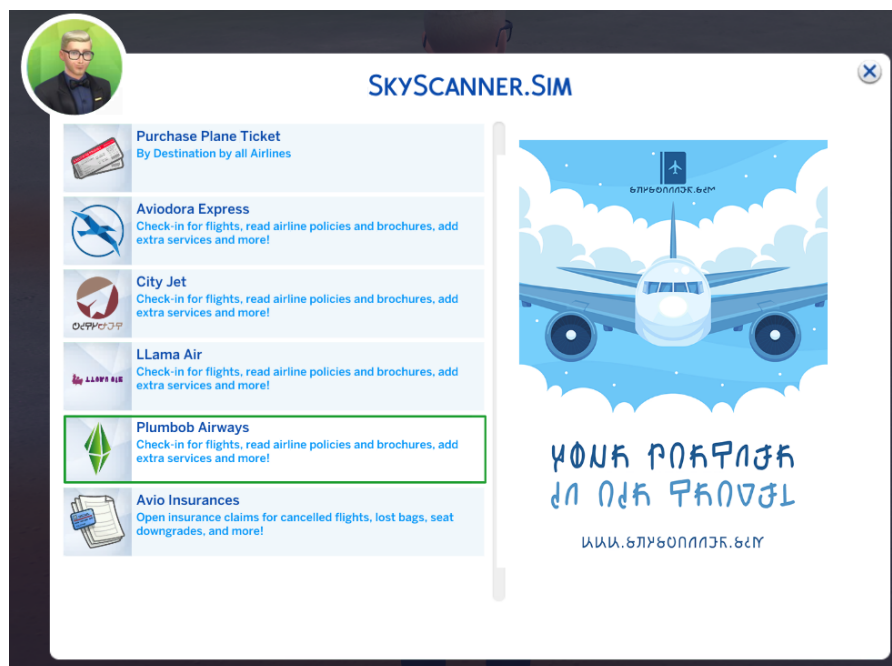
- **NPC Control:**
 - **Activate Service NPCs** (like bartenders, DJ etc.)
 - **Activate Background NPCs** (like Tourist, Hookah Lounger, Karaoke Singer etc.)
 - **Activate Open-Venues** (activate whole venues like the nightclub)
- **Season Control:** change the season
- **Weather Control:** change the current weather type
- **Focus Camera On:** locate sights and places easily
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2. Aviodora.Sim:

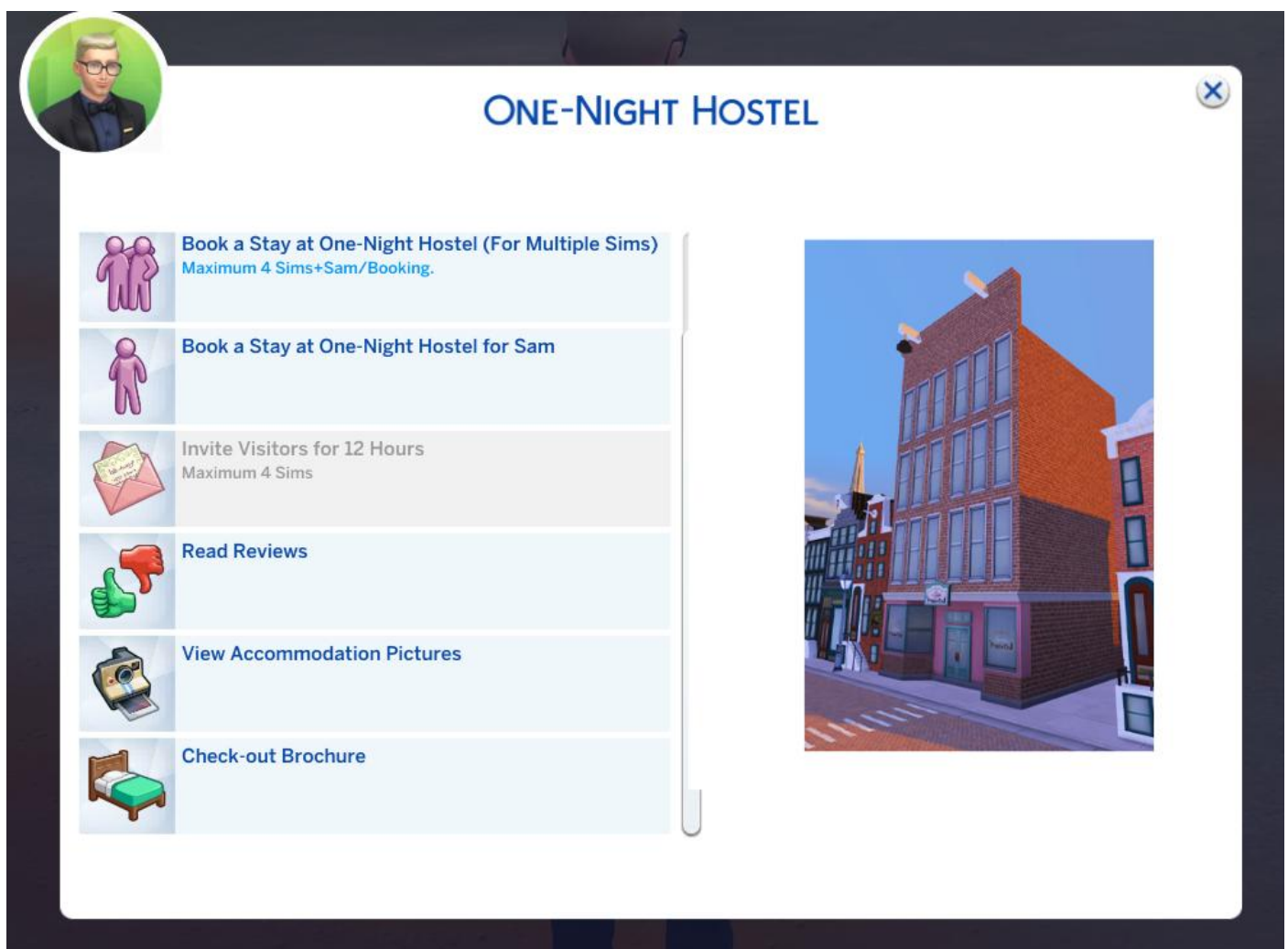
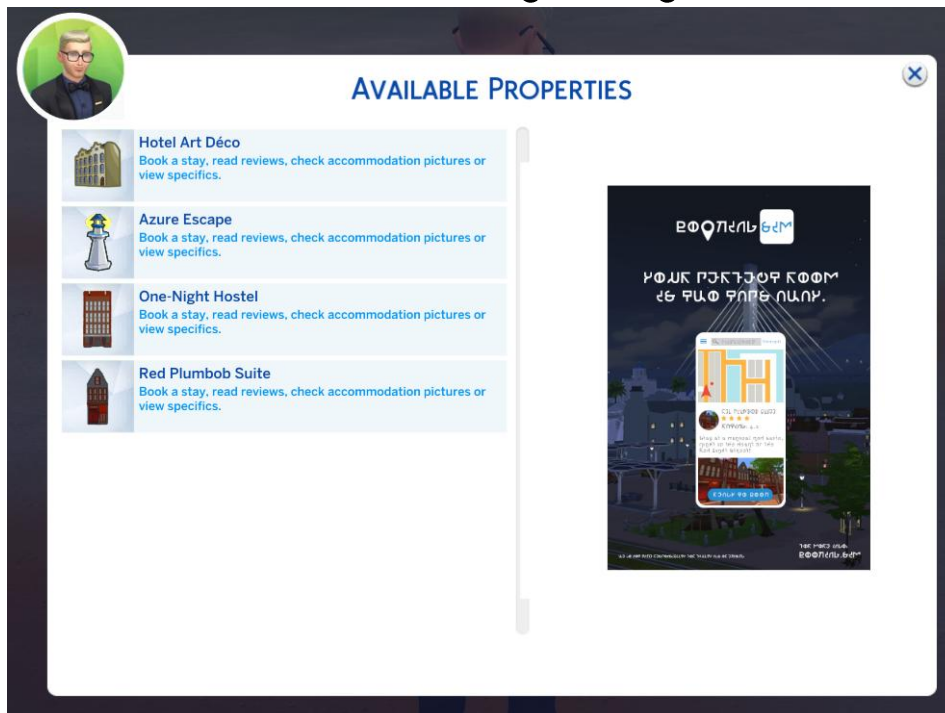
- Browse city brochures.
- Buy tickets, bike rentals, or city cards.
- Government Services:
 - Change phone numbers (if doxxed).
 - Apply for passports.
 - Start name change process.
 - Request birth certificate copies.



3. SkyScanner.Sim: Purchase flights, manage insurance claims, and visit airline websites.



4. Booking.Sim: Reserve accommodation, check reviews and pictures, and add pets or visitors to existing bookings.



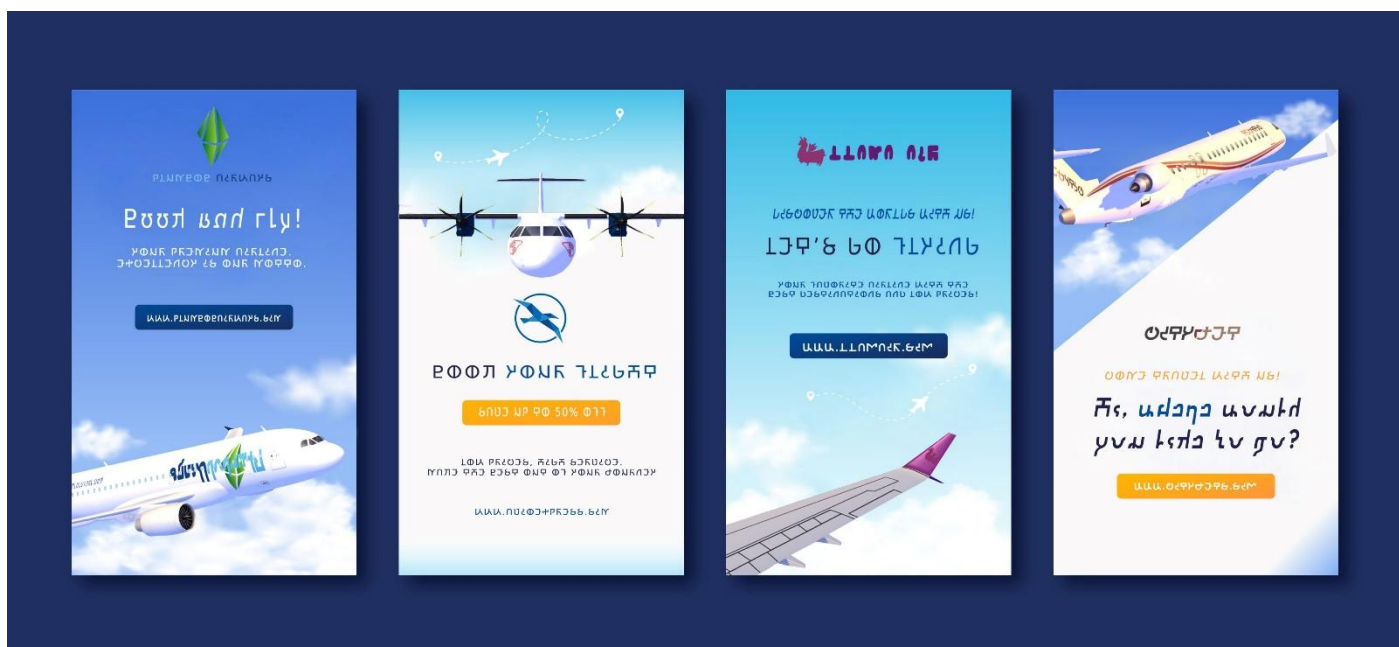
Hide Walls

Certain open-venues (One-Night Hostel, Hotel Art Déco, Azure Escape Apartment, Canal Café, Vampire Hideout, Simffeil Cinema) in Aviodora can hide and show the walls. Due to game limitations, it is not possible to toggle the walls with the in-game Wall button, however they can be individually toggled. To do that, click on the wall you want to hide and click "Hide Walls".



To unhide the walls, click the walls again and choose, "Show Walls".

Add-Ons for Tickets:

Missing perks (e.g., snacks, bags, insurance) can be purchased after ticket purchase during check-in. Access this via the airline's website on the SkyScanner.Sim app.

Check-In

There are three ways to check in:

1. Airline website via SkyScanner.Sim
2. Self-check-in kiosks at the airport
3. In-person check-in desks (requires activating the desk stalls in-game)

Legacy Airline Note: Legacy airlines like City Jet will prompt Sims to choose their class (e.g., Economy or Business) during check-in, with additional fees applied.

After Check-In

Sims can proceed through security (decorative for now) and explore the airport.

Activities at the Airport:

- **Duty-Free Shopping:** Books, travel accessories, nectar, perfumes, and region-specific items (e.g., snowboards for Mt. Komorebi, machetes for Selvadorada).
- **Batuu Travelers:** Exchange Simoleons for Galactic Credits.
- **Seasonal Fun:** Swing on the airplane swing (seasonal availability).
- **View the Apron:** Relax and watch planes on the runway.

Boarding Details:

- **Boarding Time:** Interaction to board the flight becomes available 1.5 hours before departure (e.g., for an 8:00 AM flight, boarding is open from 6:30 to 8:00 AM).
 - **Boarding Pass Scan:** Sims must scan their boarding passes before departure. Overloaded inventories on Llama Airways may result in fines.
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Flight Disruptions

1. **Cancellations & Overbooking:** Sims may face cancellations or get bumped due to overbooking. Compensation includes vouchers or dispute options (if insured).
 2. **Emergencies:** Rare emergency evacuations may occur, resulting in injuries but no fatalities (for now).
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Insurance Details

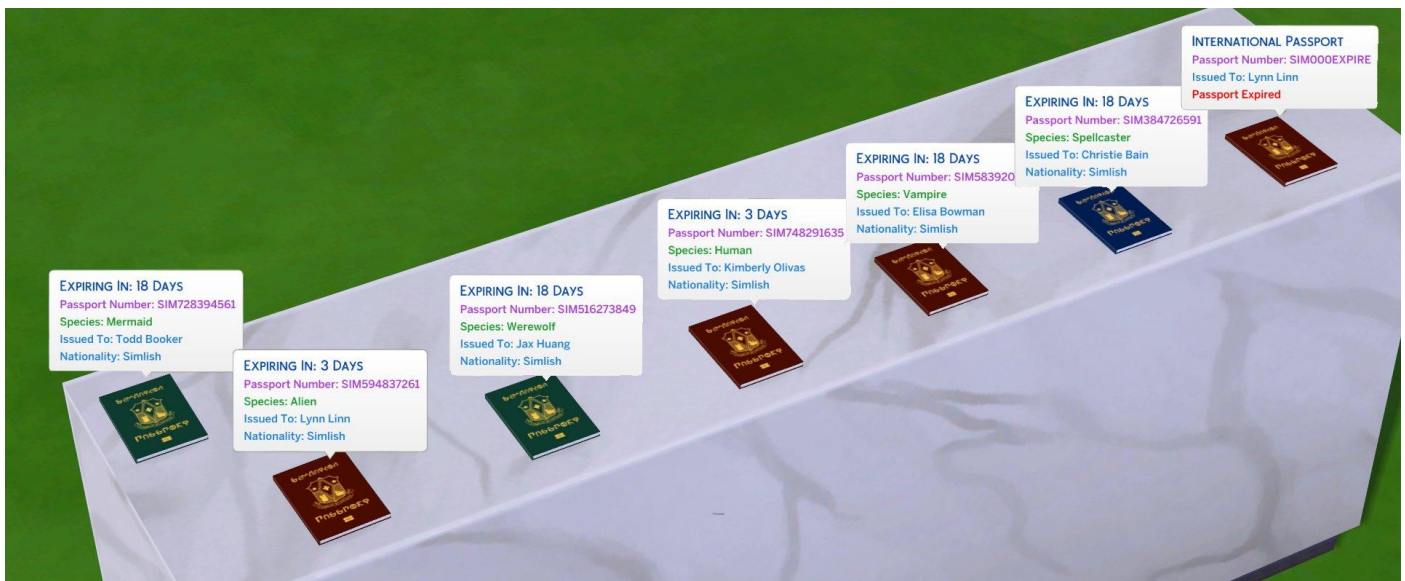
Each airline offers different levels of coverage.

Insurance claims must be filed within a few days after an eventful flight.

Passports

- **Validity Options:** 7, 21, or 45 days, with distinct passport colors based on duration.
- **Where to Obtain:** Passports can primarily be issued at City Hall on weekdays.





NPC Control (Currently only available to Patreons)

How to Set Up NPCs?

First, you need to modify the *venue type* of the lot where Aviodora is located.

Then, set the spawnable NPC number to a higher value (e.g., 60). You can either use a lot trait to automatically spawn NPCs (recommended only for high-end PCs) or manually spawn NPCs through World Control. Let's go step by step:



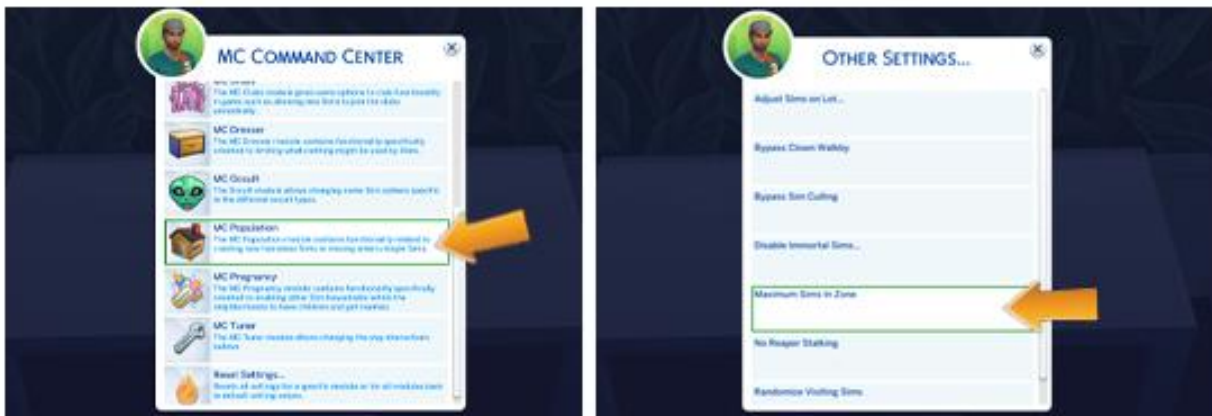
1. Venue Change:

- **Old Saves:** You need to set the venue type to either Aviodora Park or Aviodora Residential Home.
- **New Saves:** No need to change the venue type, as it will automatically be set to Aviodora Park.

2. Change NPC Limit from 20:

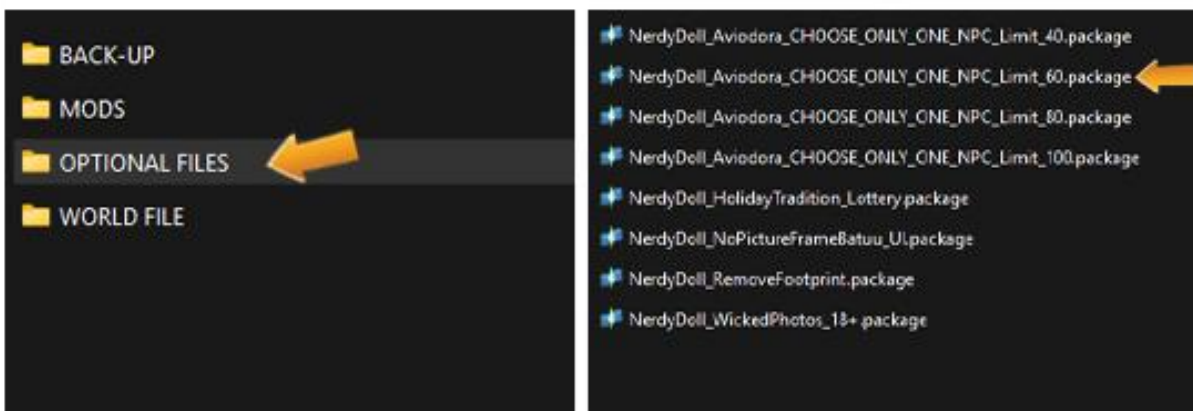
A) Use MC Command Center (MCCC):

- Click on any computer → MC Population → Other Settings → Maximum Sims in Zone
- Set it to a desirable number based on your PC's specs.



B) If you do NOT own MCCC:

- Add one of the optional files titled like:
NerdyDoll_Aviadora_CHOOSE_ONLY_ONE_NPC_Limit_40.package
- Choose only ONE file depending on your computer's specs.



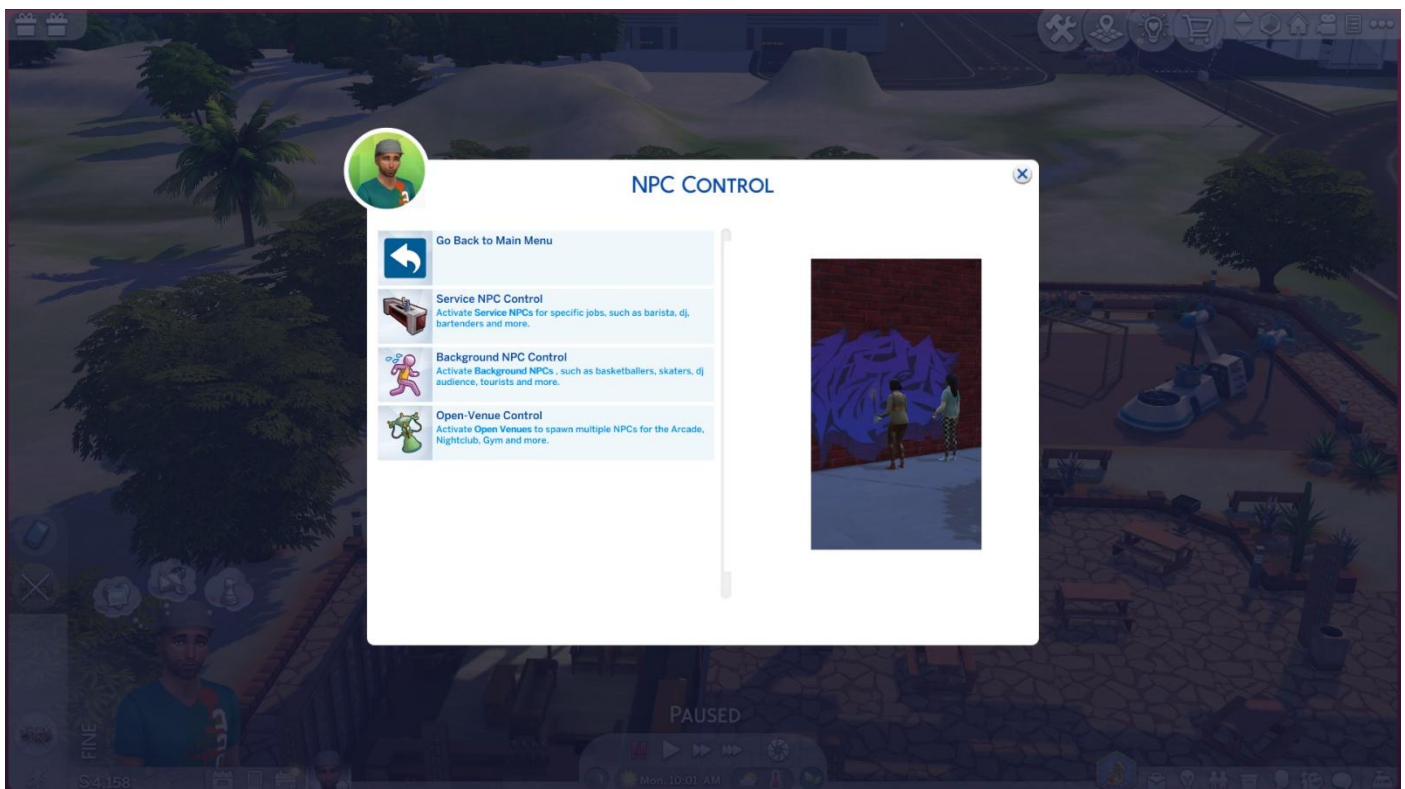
3. Activate NPCs:

- A) If you have a high-end gaming PC, you can add an Auto NPC lot trait to Aviodora. This will automatically spawn NPCs.



B) Manually spawn NPCs through World Control:

→ Spawn service NPCs, background NPCs, or activate open-venues.



I highly recommend using option B), especially if your computer is not made of the most expensive gaming specs.
