INSTRUCTIONS

Azu, Cel, Hamid, Wilde and Zolf all went out for a meal together.

No one ate the same food dish, ordered the same drink or paid the same price.

Can you find out, using the following information along with the grid, who ate which dish, who drank which drink, and who paid which price?

1. The person who had the Halloumi paid £2 more than the person who ordered the Lamb.
2. The two original members of the London Rangers (we're working on the name) had milkshakes.
3. Zolf & Wilde's meals combined cost £17, and, in Zolf's opinion, lacked salt.
4. Cel caused a bit of a ruckus by dropping a mint into their Fizzy Orange to see if the energy generated could be harnessed usefully. Luckily the mess was cleared up quickly and Azu assured Cel that the orange only served to enhance the last bite of her Chicken.
5. The meal that included the Elderflower Pressé cost £10.50; while Spicy Potatos and a drink cost £8.50.
6. The Lamb Shwarma was not part of the cheapest meal.
7. The Chocolate milkshake was served with a veggie meal.
8. One person nearly split the party by dipping his Halloumi Fries into his Strawberry Milkshake.

Image description

There are fifteen rows of squares. All the squares are of equal size.

The squares are arranged thus:

Rows one to five have fifteen squares.

Rows six to ten have ten squares.

Rows eleven to fifteen have five squares.

All the rows start in column one, so the shape of the grid is not a square, but gets shorter in steps of five rows at a time.

To the left of the grid are fifteen rows of labels, lined up with the squares, grouped into three lots of five rows.

The first group of five rows contain the names of the following RQG characters: Azu, Cel, Hamid, Wilde, Zolf.

The second group has a drink in each row: Chocolate Milkshake, Dandelion and Burdock, Elderflower Pressé, Fizzy Orange and Strawberry Milkshake.

The third group has five prices: £7.50, £8.50, £9.50, £10.50 and £11.50.

The columns have similar labels above the grid, lined up with the fifteen columns horizontally.

The first group of columns is labelled with meals: Chicken Shwarma, Falafel Wrap, Halloumi Fries, Lamb Shwarma and Spicy Potatoes.

The second group has the same five prices: £7.50, £8.50, £9.50, £10.50, £11.50.

The third group has the same five drinks: Chocolate Milkshake, Dandelion and Burdock, Elderflower Pressé, Fizzy Orange and Strawberry Milkshake.
