The maps are featured in the adventure PDF as well, though not at a battle-ready scale like these. The adventure is phenomenal and features incredible artwork, writing, and provides a much-needed higher-level adventure after your players complete the standard Curse of Strahd story. Printing the Castle

As you'll obviously see, this section only contains 5 rooms provided in full-res PNG files and a (VTT) version at half DPI for easier file management. The other remainder of the castle is visually unchanged from its Ravenloft counterpart and can be found in the other downloadable .zip folders. In those folders you'll find printing files made specifically to make printing from home as easy as possible.

With these Standing Forlorn variants, they all arrive at a scale of 1 square = ½ inch. Meaning that if you wish to play with them at the table you'll simply need to print them at 200% size. Rooms L10, L20a, L43, and L86 are small enough in scale that you may do so and print it all onto a single sheet of standard U.S. paper (8.5x11 inches). Room L20b however is just a little too big, in which case you'll want to follow this [printing guide](#) I've produced for printing the map out from home over multiple sheets of paper.
