1	The high standard of the match was set by Earhart when she used all seven of her letters on the opening move, earning her 82 points
2	The person risking their Campbell novel felt pretty good about their chances of keeping it when they scored a whopping 100 points in one turn!
3	"Maximize" was not the highest scoring word of the game. Barnes's top-scoring word was one letter shorter than Kiko's
4	If you combine the score gained by playing the word "Heading" with the highest word score of the person who bet their beautiful peacock quill, you get a Prime number
5	The person betting their harmonica had all but given it up for lost, when hope shone anew in the form of the word "Hijack" on a Double-Letter, Triple-Word combo
6	Barnes & Carter didn't particularly want to lose the items they'd bet, but thought it worth the risk to be in with a chance of winning "Explosive Love" the finale to Campbell's fan favourite <i>Passions</i> series
