

Inn the Mountain by Tom Cartos

Background

The path from Myrr to Bharzul is a journey of several days, hundreds of feet below the western most peaks of the Epicouatl mountains. Despite its prevalence as a trade route between the two cities the route is hazardous and for those not used to spending long periods below ground in the pitch dark, it can be mentally exhausting.

About halfway along the path is Berun Kraghart's Inn, dubbed by many as 'Inn the Mountain', a very welcome respite from the dark winding tunnels and dwindling rations. Visitors are treated to fine food and ale, regular performances and a soft bed. Those who visit at the right time of year might even get to experience the lantern fly mating rituals that light up the surrounding tunnels with dazzling displays for days on end.
