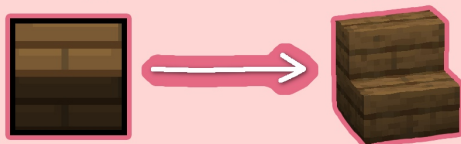


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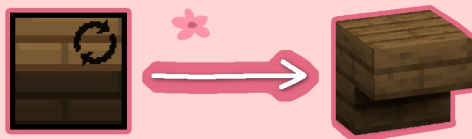
HOW TO READ 2D GUIDE - INSTRUCTIONS



This block represents a stair! (half bright, half dark)



The arrows mean it's upside down!



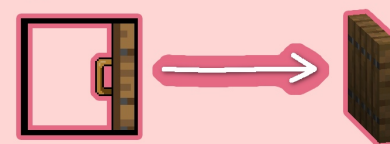
The "lower" text means it's a lower slab, like shown here!



The "upper" text means it's an upper slab, like shown here!



When you see a handle it means it's a standing trapdoor!



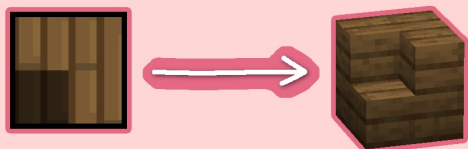
When you see a door knob it means it's a door!
Careful to not mix it with trapdoors!



This represents an outside corner block.
It can also show up with the upside down symbol!



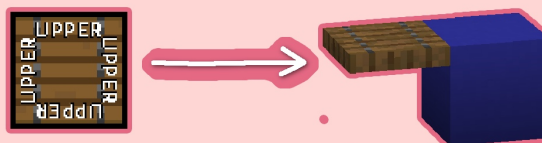
This represents an inside corner block.
It can also show up with the upside down symbol!



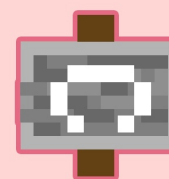
Trapdoors can also have the "lower" text, so be careful to not mix them up with slabs since they might look similar!



The "upper" text means it's an upper slab, like shown here!



C = Ceiling



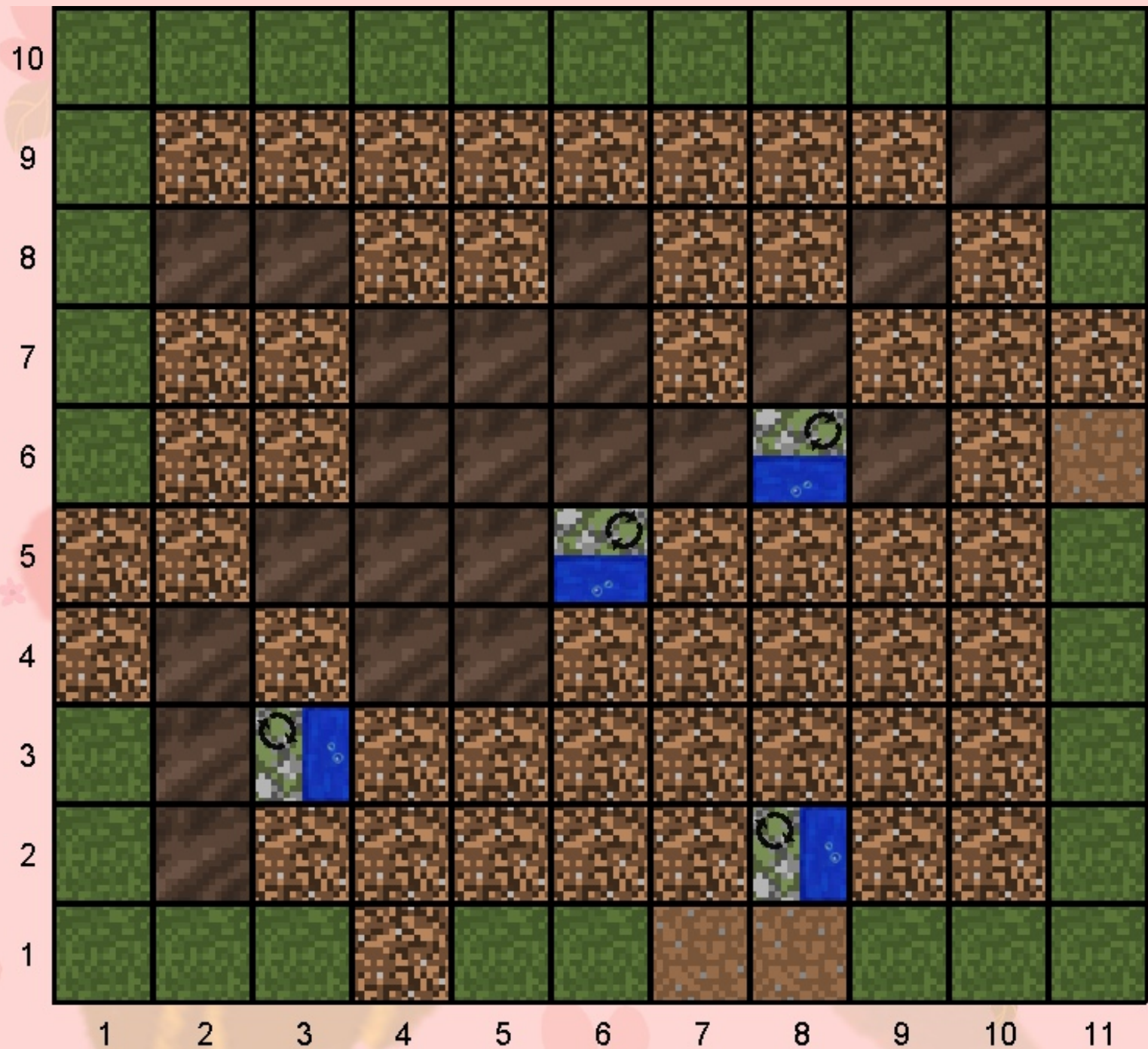
