Margaret(2):

Talks about the state of the world and the problems with low birth rates and apathy

Established in Chapter 1

Nanako(1):

Nanako talks about her classmate her classmates Mai-Chan and Emi-chan and their favorite characters. Mai-chan likes chiikawa and Emi-chan likes Anpanman

Teddie(1):

Talks about shadows and girls. Yosuke is present and they talk about a JAV series called Creampies FTW

Shadow Rise(1):

Meeting with Shadow Rise up-close in his house at night; alludes to how she misses this. The MC is confused by her words

Characters: Nanako, Chie, Yukiko, Yosuke, Teddie, Rise, Shadow Rise

Conflicts: MC amnesia, Rise's problem

Finds out that exact date is unknown with characters seemingly forgetting about it. Rise's problem isn't apparent even after interrogation. Shadow Rise provides more clues.

The protagonist wakes up, eyes wide, heart pounding.

Protagonist:

What was that dream?

It felt so real...

but why can't I remember anything before this?

My head's a mess. And Rise... she was there.

But something was wrong. Is she also trapped in this Dream World? Or is she the one behind it all?

Let me get dressed first

Margaret:

How are you doing? You've just awoken from your reality into the Dream World. It seems that you're back in the Dojima Residence.

Protagonist:

Am I the only one aware of the Dream World?

***M:** As far as I'm aware you may be. It's best to ask around and see if anyone else is aware as well.*

Am I in the past or in the future?

***M:** It's not entirely clear but you've seem to be in the past.*

Margaret:

You're trying to make sense of everything, aren't you? But in this world—the Dream World—things don't always follow the logic you're used to in the real world.

That's the nature of dreams. They twist, shift, and blur.

What seems real one moment vanishes the next.

It won't always make sense here—at least not in the way you expect.

But just because it's unclear doesn't mean there isn't truth hidden within. You have to look deeper.

Trust your instincts, not just your eyes.

-Call ends-

He grips his head, trying to make sense of it.

None of this adds up. I can't trust anything I'm seeing... but I have to figure this out. For her. For my memories. I won't stop until I know the truth.

-TV turns on-

Shadow Rise is on TV. She tells the Protagonist the date and time. She is very crass and hypersexual saying that the Dream World is infinite.

The protagonist sits alone in his room, the dim light from the window casting long shadows across the floor. Suddenly, the TV flickers on by itself, static filling the screen before the image sharpens. An anchorwoman appears, her appearance unsettlingly familiar. She smirks, leaning forward in her chair, her voice dripping with exaggerated charm.

Shadow:

"Good evening, sweetheart. It's your favorite time of day—time for me."

The protagonist stiffens, staring at the screen, his breath catching. Shadow's presence oozes a twisted sensuality, her movements slow and deliberate as she adjusts her hair.

Shadow:

"Let's see... today's date is... oh, does it even matter? Time doesn't really exist here, does it? But if you insist, it's [giggles] right about now, darling. You know... where everything's a blur, and you've lost track of it all. Mmm, delicious."

Her eyes narrow as she leans closer, her tone turning crass and taunting.

Shadow:

*"You must be wondering why you're stuck here, all alone, trying to figure out what's real. Guess what? The Dream World... it's infinite. It stretches beyond anything you can imagine. There's no end, no limits... and certainly no escape. But don't worry, sugar. I'll be here, keeping you company every step of the way." [smirking wickedly] "Isn't that just what you wanted? Someone to watch you, to see you? Hmm, or maybe you prefer a little more than just watching?"**

The protagonist glares at the screen, but can't shake the unease creeping up his spine.

Shadow:

"Oh, sweetheart, don't act so innocent. I'm you, or at least the part you don't like to admit exists. And you're here because you want to be. This is your playground, after all. The Dream World is a reflection of what you're too afraid to face... and trust me, it's a lot more fun than you think."

Protagonist:

...What am I scared of!?

S: Me of course!

You're not the real Rise. +1c(3)

S: I am a Shadow. The true self. There's no other me besides me!

Yes mommy +1L(4)

S: That's what I like to hear! Don't talk back to mommy.

Her laughter echoes, a dark, unsettling sound that fills the room as the TV flickers again, her image distorted but her smirk still visible.

Shadow:

"Now be a good boy and get comfortable. You're not leaving any time soon."

"Well it looks like Risetete has a visitor, tee hee. I'll see you later!"

> Continue watching?

Yes. YES! +1lust(5)

"Well too bad cuck boy!"

No. I don't want to see Rise do that

The screen goes black, but the ominous feeling lingers, as if Shadow's presence is still watching, waiting.

[Dojima House, Living Room]

Protagonist finds out he has school today through Nanako. Nanako and Protagonist have short conversation and Protagonist asks Nanako what day of the week is it. She doesn't know. They later promise to play together after school.

The protagonist stirs from his sleep, the unsettling dream lingering in the back of his mind. His door creaks open, and a familiar voice calls out.

Nanako:

"Good morning!"

"You've got school today!"

The protagonist rubs his eyes, sitting up in bed. He looks over to see Nanako standing in the doorway, her usual cheerful smile lighting up the room. Despite the haze of his earlier dream, her presence always brings him some comfort.

Protagonist:

"School, huh?"

"Wait who's that familiar voice?"

"Is that Nanako?"

-show scene of Nanako in her outfit POV closeup

"She looks older than when I last saw her...."

"And she's still so cute too."

-You ask Nanako what day is it-

Nanako frowns, tilting her head in thought.

Nanako:

"Um... I don't know." [giggles] "I just know you have school today. Are you ready?"

The protagonist chuckles softly, shaking his head as he gets out of bed. -You nod-

Nanako:

-close up shot cute head tilted downward

"By the way, can we hang out together after school?"

Protagonist:

"Of course. It's a promise." +1kind(1)

"I'm not sure if I'll have time for that."

Nanako nods enthusiastically, running off as the protagonist watches her go, a small smile tugging at his lips. Even in the midst of everything strange happening around him, moments like this remind him of what's important.

Inner monologue:

It seems that Nanako isn't aware of the Dream World.

-write more about nanako being older and always being so sweet, unlike Shadow Rise

Even so, I'm happy to see her again.

Now I guess I'll go to Yasogami High.

[Floodplain]

The protagonist walks down the road to school, taking in the peaceful morning air. His thoughts wander back to the strange dream he had, but he's quickly pulled out of his daze by the sound of hurried footsteps.

Yosuke:

"Hey! Hold up, partner!"

The protagonist turns, seeing Yosuke running up to him, slightly winded but with that familiar grin plastered on his face.

"Yosuke Hanamura, his dad is the manager of the Junes store in Inaba."

"We went through a lot together. From the death of Saki to bearing the brunt of the hate from the stemming from Junes, he's a tough guy."

Protagonist:

"You're always running late, huh?"

Yosuke: "Yeah, yeah. Cut me some slack."

"Nice to see you again."

Yosuke: "Uh, you too dude."

Yosuke:

Anyway, guess what? We just got this new DVD at the store—it's, uh, kinda... intense."
[Yosuke's grin widens as he raises an eyebrow] "And when I say intense, I mean it's not exactly for everyone. Definitely got some explicit content, if you know what I'm saying."

Protagonist:

"Sounds like your store's really diversifying its stock. What are you even selling over there?"

Yosuke:

"Hey, I don't pick the stuff! But trust me, this one... well, let's just say you're gonna want to see it. Problem is, I can't exactly show you at school, you know? You'd probably get me fired." [he laughs, rubbing the back of his head]

Protagonist:

"Oh, come on, it can't be that bad."

Yosuke:

"Oh, it's that bad. Or that good, depending on how you look at it. Anyway, after school, swing by the store, and maybe I'll give you a peek—once we're out of any prying eyes, of course."

The protagonist smirks, shaking his head.

Protagonist:

"Sure, I'll stop by. This better be worth the hype, though." +1L(5)

"I'm not into that stuff."

Yosuke:

"Trust me, it is. Besides, it's not like I've got anyone else to share this stuff with." [Yosuke nudges him playfully] "You're my best customer, man!" [he laughs]*

Protagonist:

"Lucky me. Alright, I'll see you after school."

Yosuke:

"Alright! And hey, maybe we'll find something even crazier while you're there."

The two continue walking, the playful banter between them easing the weight of the strange day ahead.

The protagonist stays quiet for a moment, glancing at Yukiko, who's unusually silent. She avoids eye contact, fiddling with her bag.

Protagonist:

"How about you, Yukiko? How'd you do?" 1e(3)

Yukiko hesitates, her cheeks flushing slightly.

Yukiko:

"Um... well, I... I guess I did okay."

Yosuke's eyes narrow suspiciously, a grin forming on his face.

Yosuke:

"Okay? Oh, no way. You aced it, didn't you? I can already tell!"

Yukiko fidgets, her reluctance growing as she tries to brush it off.

Yukiko:

"N-No! I mean... I just... paid attention in class."

Yosuke laughs, poking her in the side teasingly.

Yosuke:

"Yeah, yeah, 'paid attention.' You were probably sitting there like, 'Oh, this quiz is sooo easy, I'll just breeze through it while the rest of us suffer!'"

Yukiko's face turns red with embarrassment, her eyes narrowing as she clenches her fists.

Yukiko:

"That's not true! I worked hard for it! It wasn't easy at all!"

Chie bursts into laughter, doubling over at Yukiko's sudden outburst.

Chie:

"Y-Yosuke! Look at what you did! You made Yukiko mad!"

Yosuke throws his hands up in surrender, still laughing.

Yosuke:

"Alright, alright sorry! I'll stop. Geez, Yukiko, we get it—you're the quiz master."

The group continues walking down the hallway after their lighthearted banter. As they near their lockers, the protagonist, still unsettled by everything going on, decides to ask something that's been on his mind.

Protagonist:

"Hey... does anyone know what today's date is?"

Yosuke scratches his head, looking confused.

Yosuke:

"Uh... now that you mention it, I have no idea. We had that quiz and all, but the date? Yeah, no clue."

Chie:

"Huh... I didn't even think about it. Weird, I can't remember either."

Yukiko furrows her brow, clearly thinking hard, but eventually shakes her head.

Yukiko:

"It's strange, I feel like I should know, but... it's just not coming to me."

The protagonist feels a chill run down his spine. Something isn't right. He takes a breath and decides to just say it outright.

Protagonist:

"What if... we're inside a dream?"

They all stop for a second, exchanging looks, before Yosuke chuckles and shakes his head.

Yosuke:

"A dream? Dude, seriously? We're standing in the middle of school. It's gotta be the real deal."

Chie shrugs, brushing it off.

Chie:

"Yeah, maybe we're just tired or something. I mean, we've been stressed lately, right?"

Yukiko offers a soft smile, trying to be reassuring.

Yukiko:

"We've had a lot going on. It's probably just that. Maybe we're all a little out of it today."

The protagonist looks at them, his stomach sinking a bit. They're completely glossing over it, acting like nothing's out of the ordinary. But deep down, he knows something's off. He just can't shake the feeling that none of this is quite right.

Protagonist (inner monologue):

They don't get it. I don't know how, but... this is a dream. Why am I the only one who is aware it?

Yukiko suddenly perks up, a thoughtful look crossing her face.

Yukiko:

"You know... the atmosphere today does feel a little mysterious, doesn't it?"

She pauses, glancing at the others as if the realization just hit her.

Yukiko:

"And now that I think about it, isn't it club day today? Seems fitting, right?"

Yosuke groans, rubbing the back of his neck.

Yosuke:

"Oh man, not club day. Really? I was hoping to just head home after school..."

Chie:

"I almost forgot about that! We do have clubs. Yukiko, why'd you have to remind us? The mysterious vibe was kind of nice until you brought that up." [she laughs]

Yukiko gives a lighthearted shrug, smiling slightly.

Yukiko:

"Well, it feels like something is in the air. And what better way to deal with it than spending the afternoon in our clubs? It's a bit of a coincidence, don't you think?"

Chie: Well [mc name], if you're interested, Yukiko and I are in the Karate club! You should come by if you want.

Protagonist:

I'd kick your ass in karate! +1c(5)

Sounds like the perfect club for you two. +1e(5)

Yukiko: *Chie insisted on it. She said she needs to lose some fat but she looks fine.*

Ass pic of Chie

Chie: *Oh stop it Yukiko. I don't have a perfect figure like you!*

Yukiko shy pose

Yukiko blushes and laughs

Yosuke: *Anyways, there are three clubs we can check out today."*

Yosuke:

"First, there's Chie and Yukiko's Karate club—if you're in the mood for getting kicked in the face."

Chie playfully punches Yosuke in the arm, smirking.

Chie:

"I'll show you a kick in the face, Yosuke."

Yosuke laughs before continuing.

Yosuke:

"Second, we've got Kanji and Naoto's Mystery club. Sounds cool, but it's probably just them sitting around debating conspiracy theories and staring at crime photos."

He pauses, then leans in closer with a sly grin.

Yosuke:

"And finally... the VR Waifu club."

The protagonist raises an eyebrow as Yosuke waggles his eyebrows.

Yosuke:

"Yeah, you heard me. Virtual reality. Waifus. Sounds ridiculous, but hey, if you're looking for some laughs—or, you know, something weird."

Yukiko shakes her head with a sigh, and Chie crosses her arms, unimpressed.

Yukiko:

"That's a real club? How does that even work?"

Yosuke:

"Don't ask me. But it's there, just in case you're feeling adventurous."

Yosuke gives a mock-serious nod, while the protagonist contemplates which club to check out.

The atmosphere in the Mystery Club room is filled with anticipation as the group gathers around. Naoto stands at the front, arms crossed, a serious expression on their face. The room is cluttered with notes, maps, and files from past investigations. After a moment of silence, Naoto clears their throat and addresses the group.

SCENE 2: NAOTO SHOT; 4 DIFFERENT EMOTIONS (SCENE 2-6)

Naoto:

"Welcome, everyone. Before we begin our next investigation, let's start by introducing ourselves. It's important we understand each other if we're going to solve this mystery together."

SCENE 12: YOSUKE EMOTIONS (4 DIFFERENT EMOTIONS SCENE 12-16)

Yosuke:

"Yosuke Hanamura, professional slacker and part-time mystery solver, apparently."

He smirks, rubbing the back of his head.

"I'm just here to help out and make sure we don't all freak ourselves out in the process. Someone's gotta keep things light, right?"

The others chuckle slightly, though the mood stays serious.

Protagonist:

"I'm... here because something doesn't feel right. I want to understand what's really going on with these disappearances. I think it's more connected to everything we've experienced than we realize."

His tone is calm but carries a weight of determination.

Naoto:

"Good. We'll need that drive. The truth won't reveal itself easily."

Naoto gestures to the group.

"Next?"

The scene shifts as Naoto finishes the introductions. The clubroom feels even more mysterious as Naoto turns toward Tsumugi and the protagonist.

Naoto:

“We’ll need all the tools we can get for this investigation. There’s a book of riddles in the back of the library—an old tome with puzzles that might provide clues to our case. Tsumugi, you and the protagonist should go retrieve it.”

The protagonist nods, sensing the meaning behind her words.

"Yeah, I get it. Mysteries have a way of revealing truth, even when everything else seems confusing."

They finally reach the back of the library, a dusty old section with towering bookshelves. After a few moments of searching, they spot the book Naoto mentioned: an ancient-looking leather-bound tome titled "The Riddles of the Lost." Tsumugi carefully pulls it off the shelf, cradling it as if it might crumble at any moment.

"Getting groped in the back of the library by a Chad while everyone is oblivious about it!"

"> That's a specific bucket list."

"> ..."

"> This girl is something else."

"> Naoto is like this too?"

"Let's get back to the others but maybe another day we can check off another thing on my bucket list..."

Yosuke: *(laughing as they walk)* "Alright, let's see what's really on this thing!"

They see that its Kashiwagi doing self-service and they were all very interested and say they'll ask her out next time. Teddie pulls behind the MC and tells him that he's not acting like his usual self. You explain about the Dream World and Margaret

Junes backroom:

The group sits huddled around a computer screen in the dimly lit backroom. Yosuke has the DVD in hand, looking smug as always, while Kanji is fidgeting nervously, and Teddie is eagerly bouncing on his heels.

YOSUKE HAPPY CLOSE SHOT

Yosuke: (Grinning) "Alright guys, here's the deal. You know how I said Ms. Kashiwagi was kind of... uh, flirty in class? Turns out she's even worse behind closed doors."

He waves the DVD in front of them like a prize.

KANJI SKEPTICAL CLOSE SHOT

Kanji: (Crossing his arms) "You sure this is a good idea? I heard some DVDs have security stuff on 'em—like they can track who plays 'em or somethin'... We don't need no teachers comin' after us, man."

Yosuke: (Laughs) "Oh c'mon, Kanji! You're telling me you're scared of a little video? Besides, no one's gonna find out. That's why we're in the backroom. This place is perfect for something like this."

Teddie, with a gleeful look on his face, is bouncing in place.

TEDDIE HAPPY CLOSE SHOT

Teddie: (Grinning widely) "Ooh! Ooh! I'm just here for the show! I don't care who presses play, as long as I get to see *everything*."

Yosuke turns to the protagonist with a mischievous grin.

YOSUKE LOOKING AT MC SHOT

Yosuke: (Nudging the protagonist) "Well, you've been pretty quiet. How about you do the honors? Go on, sit here and pop it in."

Yosuke leans back, waiting for the protagonist to act. Meanwhile, Teddie looks more excited than ever.

MC IN SEAT SHOT WITH GUYS IN BACKGROUND

Teddie: (Chiming in) "Oh, this is going to be unbearably *steamy*...! Let's hurry and get started!"

Kanji still looks uneasy, glancing nervously at the computer screen.

Kanji: (Muttering) "Man... I dunno 'bout this. Ms. Kashiwagi's always been weird, but this... feels wrong."

Yosuke: (Shrugging) "Hey, we're just... investigating, alright? No harm in a little curiosity."

The room grows tense as they wait for the protagonist's decision.

Setting: Junes Backroom, moments after the video ends.

The computer screen goes dark as the explicit video finishes playing. The group sits in stunned silence, each one processing what they've just seen.

KANJI SHOT

Kanji: *W-what happened to the video?*

YOSUKE SHOT

Yosuke: *Damn it! I think it crashed but...*

WIDE SHOT 1

Yosuke: (Wide-eyed, shaking his head) "I can't believe Ms. Kashiwagi would actually do something like *that*... I mean, I knew she was... bold, but damn."

He laughs nervously, scratching his head.

Yosuke: "I mean... should I ask her out? Maybe she's into younger guys... but what if she's, like, way too rough? I'm not sure if I could handle that."

Kanji is sitting with his arms crossed, looking conflicted. He shifts uncomfortably, clearly surprised but trying to stay composed.

Kanji: (Huffing) "Yeah, it's wild, but... nah, I ain't gonna get involved in that mess. I gotta stay loyal to Naoto."

He quickly adds, almost as if convincing himself.

"Even though we're not... you know... *dating* or nothin'."

Teddie, who was grinning the whole time during the video, is practically bouncing out of his seat now.

Teddie: (Giggling mischievously) "Ohhh boy, I'll *definitely* be at school tomorrow! I didn't know our teachers had *that* kinda extra credit! I wonder if she'll give me some 'one-on-one tutoring.'"

Yosuke throws him a disgusted look.

Yosuke: "Seriously, Teddie? You've got no shame, man..."

Teddie just winks and sticks out his tongue playfully.

Teddie: "Hey, I'm just embracing the possibilities! You humans are always so shy about your feelings. Besides, you know you're all thinking it too!"

The group chuckles awkwardly, still a bit shaken by what they've seen. The atmosphere in the backroom is a mix of shock, disbelief, and some lingering tension. The protagonist watches silently, processing the reactions as they unfold, unsure how to feel about the whole situation.

Yosuke: (Sighing, leaning back in his chair) "Man... this whole thing's messed up. I just thought we'd have a good laugh, not... *this*."

Kanji stands up, rubbing the back of his neck.

Kanji: "Yeah, no kidding. Let's... not tell anyone about this, alright?"

They all agree, the gravity of what they've seen starting to sink in, even if Teddie is still grinning like it's all a joke.

Teddy is originally ... a Shadow. He's a shadow, just like the shadows you battle. But he developed a conscience, he knew he was a Shadow and was very lonely, knowing that nobody would like him as a Shadow. So he ended up creating himself in the image of a teddy, to appeal to people and be liked by them.

This conscience went so far that he even got a Persona out of his, and then did sit ups until he gained a body... likely due to his intense wish, again, of being human and appealing to people. So the Teddy is not "just" a costume, it's kind of like a costume that becomes sentient when he puts it on.

He's a real waste of potential in my opinion. We could have had fresh insights into what shadows are, why they attack, why humans supposedly turn into shadows if the villains win, or at least seen properly the confusion a person who is born from nothing experiences. As it is he's just kinda there, and the fact he's a shadow is just revealed as a cheap big shock rather than actually having any significance or providing any information.

Shadows are physical manifestations, or also referred to as a Jungian archetypical being of a humans' subconscious, which explained why they had aggressive behavior. Shadows are generally hostile towards their human counterparts.

Social Link rank-up

Setting: Junes Backroom. Yosuke and Kanji have just left to clean up the table outside, leaving the Protagonist and Teddie alone.

Teddie stands next to the Protagonist, looking at him thoughtfully. There's a pause before Teddie gently stops him by grabbing his sleeve.

Teddie:

"Hey, wait a sec... you've been acting *different* lately. You're not the same as before."

Teddie's tone is uncharacteristically serious, his eyes searching the Protagonist's face.

"I can *feel* it."

The Protagonist remains silent for a moment, unsure of how to explain the swirling confusion in his head. He finally speaks up, mentioning the Dream World. Teddie listens, his expression slowly growing more concerned.

Teddie:

"Dream World, huh...? So that's why you've seemed so off lately."

The Protagonist nods, explaining how he's trapped, how nothing feels real, and how he's been struggling to figure out what's happening. Teddie lets the information sink in, looking unusually serious for the normally goofy bear.

Teddie:

"Y'know, this Dream World of yours... it reminds me a lot of the Shadows we used to fight."

The Protagonist gives him a questioning look, and Teddie crosses his arms, thinking back.

Teddie:

"Shadows... they're born from people's feelings. And when those feelings are strong enough, they become real—just like the Shadows you battled. But there's something interesting about them..."

Teddie looks at him with a knowing smile, then continues.

Teddie:

"Shadows, like me, sometimes develop a conscience. They end up creating themselves in the image of something they think people *want*—something that'll make them liked or accepted. It's like they're trying to fit in, but deep down, they're still just shadows. Lost. Searching for something... or someone."

Teddie's eyes soften a bit as he watches the Protagonist, as if he's thinking of something beyond the words he's saying.

Teddie:

"Maybe this Dream World... it's like that. Maybe it's feeding off your feelings, twisting things to confuse you. Trying to show you what you *want* to see... or maybe what you're afraid of."

He places a paw on the Protagonist's shoulder, his playful tone slipping back just a bit.

Teddie:

"Whatever it is, you're not alone in this. You've got me and everyone else to help, okay? We'll figure it out, together."

The Protagonist quietly considers Teddie's words, feeling a small bit of clarity in the haze of his confusion. For once, the ever-mischievous bear is right.

Setting: Junes Backroom.

Just as Teddie finishes his reassuring words, the TV in the corner of the room suddenly flickers to life. The screen, once dark and silent, crackles with static before a figure begins to materialize. Shadow Rise appears on the screen, but something's off—she's standing on a beach, dressed in a swimsuit, looking relaxed and smug. The atmosphere becomes tense.

Shadow Rise:

"Teddie, Teddie, Teddie... You're so wrong about this Dream World."

Her voice drips with mockery, her smile twisted into something unsettling.

"None of it matters. These friends, these little moments you're all clinging to? They won't accomplish anything."

Teddie's eyes widen, and he steps back instinctively, but the Protagonist stands firm, fists clenched. Anger flickers in his eyes as Shadow Rise continues.

Shadow Rise:

"You're stuck here, forever. Trapped in this little fantasy, where nothing you do will make a difference. It's all pointless..."

Her eyes narrow, focusing on the Protagonist with a knowing, almost teasing look.

"And you, dear, sweet Protagonist... you'll never escape. No matter how hard you try, no matter how many questions you ask, you'll always be here, in this fake world."

The Protagonist takes a step toward the TV, frustration boiling over as his eyes lock onto her. His mind races—he demands to know where she is, where this taunting nightmare version of Rise is hiding.

Protagonist (Choice: Courage):

"Where are you?! Tell me where you're at!"

Shadow Rise laughs, the sound cold and echoing against the gentle crashing of waves behind her. She tilts her head, her expression turning almost wistful.

Shadow Rise:

"This beach? It's special, you know. A place that we share... something only you and I can remember."

She grins, the edge in her voice returning.

"But don't worry, you won't have to search for me. I'll find you."

Her image on the screen leans in, her eyes gleaming with dark intent.

Shadow Rise:

"And when I do... you'll wish you'd never asked."

With that, the TV suddenly goes dark, the flickering light gone as quickly as it appeared. The room falls silent, leaving Teddie and the Protagonist standing there in the oppressive stillness. The tension in the air is thick, and the Protagonist's mind is reeling.

Teddie:

"...That was... intense."

His voice is shaky, a stark contrast to the confidence he had just moments ago.

The Protagonist remains silent, his gaze fixed on the now-blank TV screen, determination burning in his chest.

JUNES WITH RISE

Ideas: **changing room with Rise**, seeing Nanako change clothes, the guys check out the CD, they fight over the CD, they talk about the dream world and girls, rise comes in and takes mc away from them

Bargain bin porn actor

MC, Yosuke, and Teddie Intro: They talk about girls and Yosuke shows MC the explicit DVD. Rank-up 1 with Teddie.

Yosuke and Teddie try to open the DVD with the kids seal and Teddie nearly breaks it

Meet with Rise. Talks about Dream World. If expression is over 5, Rise show's her bikini (very lewd and hot scenes) (if expression 5, you get blowjob), rise talks about her emotions, gets really sad, you ask her out on a beach date with the crew tomorrow

High expression = blowjob

Shadow Rise appears on computer and says if he's not gonna confront her she's gonna confront him

MC continues interrogation about Dream World and other things

(Meet with Rise, Yosuke, Kanji)

- Kanji almost spills the beans about the tape but Yosuke stops him
- Yosuke conveniently leaves with Kanji

(MC pulls Rise aside and they talk and Rise says she's not aware of anything)

- Rise makes several jokes
- Asks you questions about Dream World
- She says she's getting bored

- Expression points
- You don't want to be a lame so you think of some activities to do

Activities with Rise (Quest):

- (Cloth-shopping)
 - You get to see Rise change clothes
 - Blowjob
- (Look around)
 - Look at the TV and talk about TV World
 - Rise asks you if you prefer her or Shadow Rise
- (Ask her questions)
 - About work
 - Asks back
 - Favorite memory
 - What she sees in a guy
 - Asks back

(Eat lunch)

- Choose between sloppy meal, water and salad, sushi

(Emotional moment with Rise)

(Kiss when leaving)

(MC understands the importance of maintaining the relationship even though it might be fake and it's a dream)

WIDE SHOT 1

Protagonist

Stands silently as Kanji and Yosuke argue nearby.

-

RISE CLOSEUP

Rise

(Teasingly, with a big smile) "There you are! I was wondering when you'd show up. Don't tell me you forgot our date, *partner*."

KANJI CLOSEUP

Kanji

(Whispering to Yosuke) "Man, I'm still worried about that DVD. What if someone—"

YOSUKE CLOSEUP

Yosuke

(Loudly interrupting) "Shut it, Kanji! Not here!" *Glances nervously at Rise.* "Let's, uh, go clean something up. Over there."

KANJI CLOSEUP

Kanji

(Skeptical) "What? What are we cleaning?"

YOSUKE CLOSEUP

Yosuke

(Dragging Kanji away) "Anything! Just come on!"

RISE CLOSEUP AGAIN

Rise

(Watching them go, chuckling) "They're so obvious. Did you blackmail them or something?" *Playfully nudges the Protagonist.*

The Protagonist stays quiet, choosing to focus on Rise.

Rise

(Slyly) "You're way too quiet. It's kinda cute though. But don't think you can get away with ignoring me." *She winks.*

Protagonist selects a response:

- **[Expression]:** "I'd never ignore you, Rise. What do you want to do today?" **expression #8**
- **[Courage]:** "Are you jealous I was with them first?"
- **[Lust]:** "I was just distracted... by how great you look."

Rise

(Response varies based on choice)

1. *(Blushing, grinning)* "Aww, that's sweet. You're forgiven... for now."
2. *(Pretending to pout)* "Jealous? Me? ...Okay, maybe just a little. You're mine today, got it?"
3. *(Laughing, leaning closer)* "Smooth talker! You're gonna have to work harder to impress me, though."

Rise

"Let's get moving before I steal you away for something inappropriate. Just kidding! ...Unless?"
She laughs, her voice lilting as she playfully grabs the Protagonist's arm.

The two head off together toward Junes' main area.

Protagonist

Sits silently for a moment, then glances at Rise.

"Do you know anything about the Dream World?"

Rise

Blinks, feigning innocence as she leans back in her chair.

"The Dream World? Nope, never heard of it."

Protagonist

Keeps his eyes on her, unconvinced.

Rise

Smiling, but tilting her head curiously "Why? What's it like in there? You've been acting kinda weird lately."

Protagonist

(Option to choose a tone):

1. **[Kindness]**: "It's confusing. Everything feels... off."
2. **[Courage]**: "It's a trap. We shouldn't be here."
3. **[Lust]**: "Let's just say it's full of surprises. Some of them... nice."

Rise

(Reacting to the Protagonist's choice)

1. *(Softly)* "That sounds rough... No wonder you're so tense."
2. *(Concerned)* "A trap? That sounds serious. But hey, you're tough—you'll figure it out."
3. *(Teasing)* "Ooh, surprises, huh? You better not be talking about anyone else!"

Protagonist

After pausing, begins explaining his experiences in the Dream World.

"It's like... everything's familiar but not. My friends don't remember things they should, and I keep seeing... Shadows. And Rise, it's like I don't even know what's real anymore."

Rise

Leaning closer, her expression softening.

"That's heavy. You've really been through a lot, huh?"

Protagonist

"It feels like I'm stuck, like nothing I do will make a difference. It's—"

Rise

Interrupting, suddenly brightening up "Whoa, okay, timeout! This is getting way too depressing. Let's lighten things up."

Protagonist

Raises an eyebrow.

Rise

"Here's a question for you: what do you call it when someone throws something away—'trash' or 'rubbish'?"

Protagonist

Blinks, caught off guard. "Trash. Who even says 'rubbish'?"

Rise

Laughing "Uh, people with class? It's called vocabulary, you caveman!"

Protagonist

Smirking slightly "Oh, so using a fancy word for garbage makes you better than me now?"

Rise

"Absolutely. Rubbish is refined. Trash is just... trashy."

Protagonist

"Still means the same thing, doesn't it?"

Rise

Grimacing playfully "Oh no, no, no. Words have vibes. Trash is harsh; rubbish is elegant. You'd understand if you were sophisticated like me."

Protagonist

"Sure, let's pretend arguing about garbage is sophisticated."

Rise

Bursting into laughter "See? Much better than being all gloomy. Besides, I'd hate for you to start looking like the rubbish you're arguing for."

Protagonist

Shaking his head but letting out a small laugh.

Rise

Smiling warmly "There we go. You laugh, I win. Now, tell me more, but this time... try to keep it from sounding like we're in a horror movie, okay?"

Rise

Resting her chin on her palm, spinning a straw around in her drink.

"So, the Dream World, huh? Sounds like a trippy place. But... I gotta say, this is getting a little too heavy for me."

Protagonist (*Silent, glancing at Rise*) (*Choice Option*):

1. **[Expression]**: "Sorry, I didn't mean to make it so serious. Let's change the subject."
#expression 9
2. **[Lust]**: "Bored, huh? I could think of something fun to do."
#lust 7

Rise (*Reacting to choice*):

1. (*Smiling softly*) "Aw, see? That's why you're such a good guy. Always thinking of me."
2. (*Grinning with anticipation*) "Now you're speaking my language. Got something in mind?"
3. (*Playfully blushing*) "Oh? Careful, or I might take that the wrong way~."

Protagonist

(*Decisively*) "How about this? We've got three options: we can go clothes shopping, check out the rest of Junes, or... we keep talking. Call it 'interrogation,' if you want."

Rise (*Laughing lightly*) "Wow, 'interrogation,' huh? You're making it sound all official now. But shopping, Junes, or sitting around? Hmm..."

(*She taps her finger on her cheek, pretending to think hard.*)

Rise (*Playfully*) "What if I said I wanted to do all three? You'd have to carry all my bags, show me all the fun spots here, and spill every secret you're keeping. Think you can handle that?"

(*The Protagonist silently raises an eyebrow, waiting for her real answer.*)

Rise (*Giggling*) "Okay, okay! I'll pick one. But don't forget, this is our *date*, so you better keep it interesting~."

(This dialogue lets players feel involved, giving them clear choices while keeping Rise's flirty and spirited personality intact.)

Activities with Rise (Quest):

- (Cloth-shopping)
 - You get to see Rise change clothes
 - Blowjob
- (Look around)
 - Look at the TV and talk about TV World
 - Rise asks you if you prefer her or Shadow Rise
- (Ask her questions)
 - About work
 - Asks back
 - Favorite memory
 - What she sees in a guy
 - Asks back

Cloth Shopping

You and Rise talk about clothes and she likes buying expensive brands and harujuku style clothing

She asks you what type of clothes you like

SALES bin

Rise bends over you stand over her

She will show you 3 outfits

Very modern dress

Harujuku style dress

Bikini with pants and cute slippers

Rise says since she's your girlfriend now you're allowed to come to the dressing room and see her clothes

She invites you to come inside the dressing room and watch her undress

If expression is high enough:

She gives you blowjob

Scene: Junes Clothing Store

(The protagonist and Rise wander through the clothing aisles, the bustling noise of shoppers filling the air. Rise's eyes light up as she pulls a vibrant, patterned jacket off the rack.)

#WIDE SHOT

Rise:

"Flashy Harajuku-style clothes like this are totally my vibe! Bold, eye-catching—kinda like me, right?"

(She twirls the jacket in her hands before noticing a sales bin nearby. She gasps and crouches down to rummage through it.)

#SHOT PANNING TO SALES BIN

#SHOT STILL ON SALES BIN

Rise:

"Look at this! A treasure trove of bargains. You might not get it, but the thrill of finding a cute outfit on sale? Totally unbeatable!"

(She pulls out a stylish cropped sweater.)

#SHOT OF RISE BENDING DOWN FOR BIN #1 SCHOOL CLOTHE

Rise:

"Wait here—I'll try this on real quick. You gotta tell me if it's boyfriend-approved!"

#SECOND SHOT CLOSE UP OF ASS

Scene: Rise's Fashion Show

(Rise steps out of the dressing room in the cropped sweater and strikes a playful pose.)

#SHOT OF RISE WEARING CUTE DRESS WITH MULTIPLE POSES

#POV SHOT

Rise:

"Tada! What do you think?"

(A menu pops up with choices.)

1. **"It looks great on you!"** (+Kindness)
(Rise beams, hands on her hips.)
Rise: "Knew it! You've got good taste."
 2. **"It's okay, I guess."**
(Rise pouts, placing her hands on her hips.)
Rise: "Really? I'll take that as 'you love it but you're just too shy to admit it.'"
 3. **"It's missing something... maybe me next to you?"** (+Lust)
(Rise giggles and playfully nudges you.)
Rise: "Smooth. But I think this sweater deserves its own spotlight!"
-

(She disappears back into the changing room and emerges again, this time in a flowy sundress.)

Rise:

"Okay, outfit number two! How about this one?"

(Another set of choices appears.)

1. **"You look stunning!"** (+Kindness)
(Rise blushes slightly, twirling in the dress.)
Rise: "You're such a sweet-talker!"
 2. **"Not as good as the first one."**
(Rise narrows her eyes playfully.)
Rise: "Well, someone's hard to please! Guess I'll just have to try harder."
 3. **"I can't decide—I'm distracted by your smile."** (+Lust)
(Rise covers her mouth, laughing.)
Rise: "Oh, stop! You're gonna make me blush."
-

(For the third and final outfit, Rise pulls out a bold, figure-hugging dress and grins mischievously.)

Rise:

"Okay, last one. But this time... you're coming with me."

(She grabs your wrist, tugging you toward the changing room. You hesitate, but her playful smile makes it hard to resist.)

Rise: *(In a teasing whisper.)*

"Come on, boyfriend privileges! Besides, I might need your 'fashion advice.'"

(The screen fades to black, and the sound of playful laughter comes from the changing room. When the screen fades back in, Rise steps out in the dress, looking at you expectantly.)

Rise:

"Well? What's the verdict, Mr. Fashion Expert?"

(A final set of choices appears.)

1. **"It's perfect—you're perfect."** (+Kindness)
(Rise blushes deeply, looking genuinely touched.)
Rise: "You always know just what to say... lucky me."
2. **"I'd buy that dress just to see you wear it again."** (+Lust)
(Rise smirks, placing a hand on her hip.)
Rise: "You better keep that promise, mister."
3. **"Let's get it and head out before you tempt me too much."**
(Rise laughs, pulling you closer.)
Rise: "I like the sound of that. Come on, let's go!"

(The scene ends with Rise holding her favorite outfit while clinging to your arm, clearly satisfied with your "input.")

CHECK OUT JUNES

Looking at TV

Rise asks question about TV World

You two walk towards the food stand (animation)

Get food

Animation POV of looking at Rise and she notices you

Rise *(Staring at the TV, arms crossed loosely)*

"You know, it's kind of weird seeing this thing now. Back then, it was our way into something bigger... scarier."

(She tilts her head, her reflection faintly visible in the screen.)

"Now it's just a regular TV. No static, no creepy voices, no drama. Kinda boring, huh?"

(She glances at you, a teasing smile tugging at her lips.)

"Bet you don't miss landing face-first in there. That was your signature move."

Rise *(leaning against the TV, her eyes studying you intently)*

"Hey, can I ask you something?"

(She hesitates for a moment, then smirks, trying to mask the seriousness of her question.)

"Be honest... who do you like better? Shadow Me... or the real me?"

(She tilts her head, her voice carrying a teasing edge, but her eyes betray a flicker of genuine curiosity.)

"I mean, Shadow Rise was... *bold*, right? All flirty and confident. Not afraid to say exactly what she wanted."

(She leans in slightly, lowering her voice playfully.)

"Bet she kept you on your toes."

(After a beat, she looks away, brushing her hair back with a nervous laugh.)

"But I guess that's not fair to ask, huh? Forget I said anything."

(A choice menu appears for the player.)

1. **Kindness (Kind):** *"I like the real you, Rise."*

(Rise looks surprised but smiles softly, her eyes glimmering with relief.)

"You really mean that? Thanks... I guess I needed to hear it."

2. **Courage (Brave):** *"Both of you are Rise. Shadow Rise just said what you were afraid to admit."*

(Rise blinks, her expression caught between shock and contemplation.)

"Huh... never thought of it like that. So, you're saying I should embrace all of me, huh?"

3. **Lust (Flirty):** *"Shadow Rise definitely knew how to spice things up, but I like this you too."*

(Rise raises an eyebrow, leaning closer with a teasing grin.)

"Ohhh, so you liked *her*, huh? Careful, or I might start getting ideas."

(No matter the choice, Rise chuckles softly and brushes it off, though her expression shows that your response lingered with her.)

"Well, either way... you're stuck with me now, so you better get used to it."

Rise "Oh wow, it looks like Junes has new food stalls over there! Let's check it out boyfriend!"

Mc "Seems like Rise is really enjoying Junes' new cuisine."

Mc "She's unbelievably cute when she eats."

Rise "What's wrong?"

Rise "You don't like cookies?"

Rise "You can throw them in the XXX, later!"

Scene black with fade

"You two enjoyed the cookies together."

EXTRA INTERROGATION

Get drinks to talk about stuff

Rise says play 2 truths and a lie

Rise:

"This interrogation stuff is starting to feel... stale. Let's make it spicier!"

(She winks, her tone playful.)

Rise:

"How about we play a little game of *Two Truths and a Lie*? You guess which one's the lie, and I'll even throw in a reward for you if you get it right!"

(I need to figure this out. This Dream World... it's not just a coincidence. There's a reason I'm here, and I have to uncover it before it's too late.)

*(The night stretches on as the protagonist sits in silence, determined yet uneasy, the mystery of the Dream World weighing heavily on his mind.)

Dojimanight3 head upright

Scene: The Protagonist's Room – Night

Pan right to left

(A sudden, loud knock echoes through the room. The protagonist's heart skips a beat. He looks toward the door, confused.)

Protagonist's Thoughts:

(Nanako? It's pretty late for her to still be up...)

(He stands, crossing the room to the door, but as he reaches for the handle, he realizes it's locked—from the inside. A chill creeps down his spine as he slowly turns around.)

*(Behind him, in the dim light, stands **Shadow Rise**. Her figure is shrouded in an ominous, flickering aura, her golden eyes gleaming with malice. Her smirk is playful, but her intent feels suffocating.)*

Shadow Rise: *(mockingly)*

“Awww, what's the matter? Cat got your tongue?” *(She steps closer, her gaze piercing.)*

“Did you think you were safe here, all cozy in your little room? How cute. But *you* should know better.”
