

#11.1 Winter Forest - Snow Pine Tree



Kit's Contents:

This document contains everything you need to complete the model above. More specifically, when you assemble the model you will have:

- 1 Snow Pine Tree
- 1 Bigger Snow Pine Tree
- 1 Biggest Snow Pine Tree

Extra Materials:

- Alcohol based glue, white glue, etc. Avoid applying glue to the printed parts since the ink can bleed. Use a very thin layer of when using glue to avoid creasing. Wait for it to dry completely before using.
- Exacto knife. Some pieces are very small and will be easier to cut with a knife than scissors.
- Ruler, preferably metal. This will help you cut the pieces straight.
- Special cutting mat. This will avoid damaging the working surface.
- A damp cloth to clean your fingers from the glue during the assembly.
- Extra: A pen without ink to emboss fold-ups.

Getting Started:

- 1 - Print this document with the normal quality settings of your printer. You may skip the instructions and print only the patterns below.
- 2 - Wash your hands.
- 3 - Score or emboss the pieces in the dotted lines.
- 4 - Cut all pieces on the solid line and fold them on the dotted lines.
- 5 - Get rid of all spare paper bits before starting the assembly.

Tips:

- If you are using stick glue, make sure to cover the whole tab.
- Use a spare piece of paper to put below your pieces to avoid getting it on the table.
- Use a ruler and an exacto knife over a special mat or thick cardboard, to cut the pieces out. Some details are very small and it's easier to get them this way.
- Make very superficial cuts over the dotted lines to make the folding down easier (Scoring). Be very careful to apply the least amount of pressure you can to avoid cutting all the way through.
- If you cut all the way through, you can still fix the tab in place using adhesive tape in the back.
- Roll the inkless pen over the fold up lines to make them easier to fold.

General Instructions:

- 1 - Score the dotted lines, emboss the dot and slash lines. Cut along the solid lines, making sure to be as exact as possible. Write in the back of each piece the identifying number and letters and put the instructions nearby for assembly.
- 2 - Fold the dotted lines down, with the printed part facing you, and the dot and slashed ones up. Get rid of the spare parts to avoid clutter.
- 3 - Glue all white tabs on the printed side of one piece, being careful not to get your fingers dirty with the glue.
- 4 - Stick the glued tabs to the blank side of the paper to form the model, following the guide arrows and ID codes, making sure the white tabs are covered completely by the colored paper. You can aid yourself with tweezers or a stick to press the tabs against the paper uniformly.
- 5 - Let the glue dry, and you're done!

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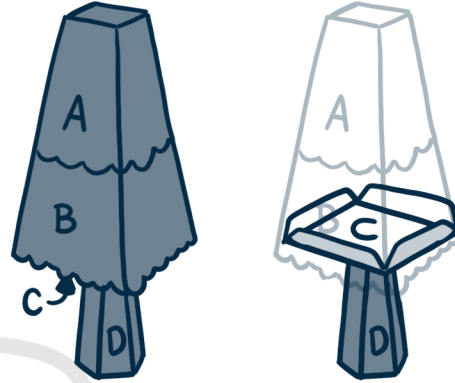
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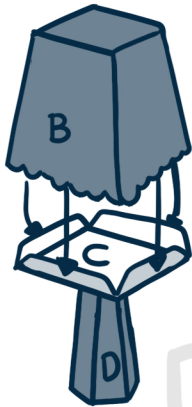

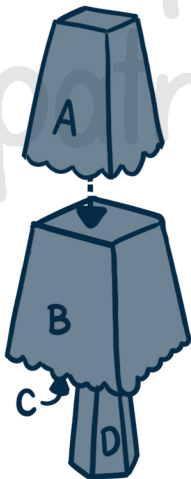
Building Instructions



i Build D. Paste to the center of printed side of C.



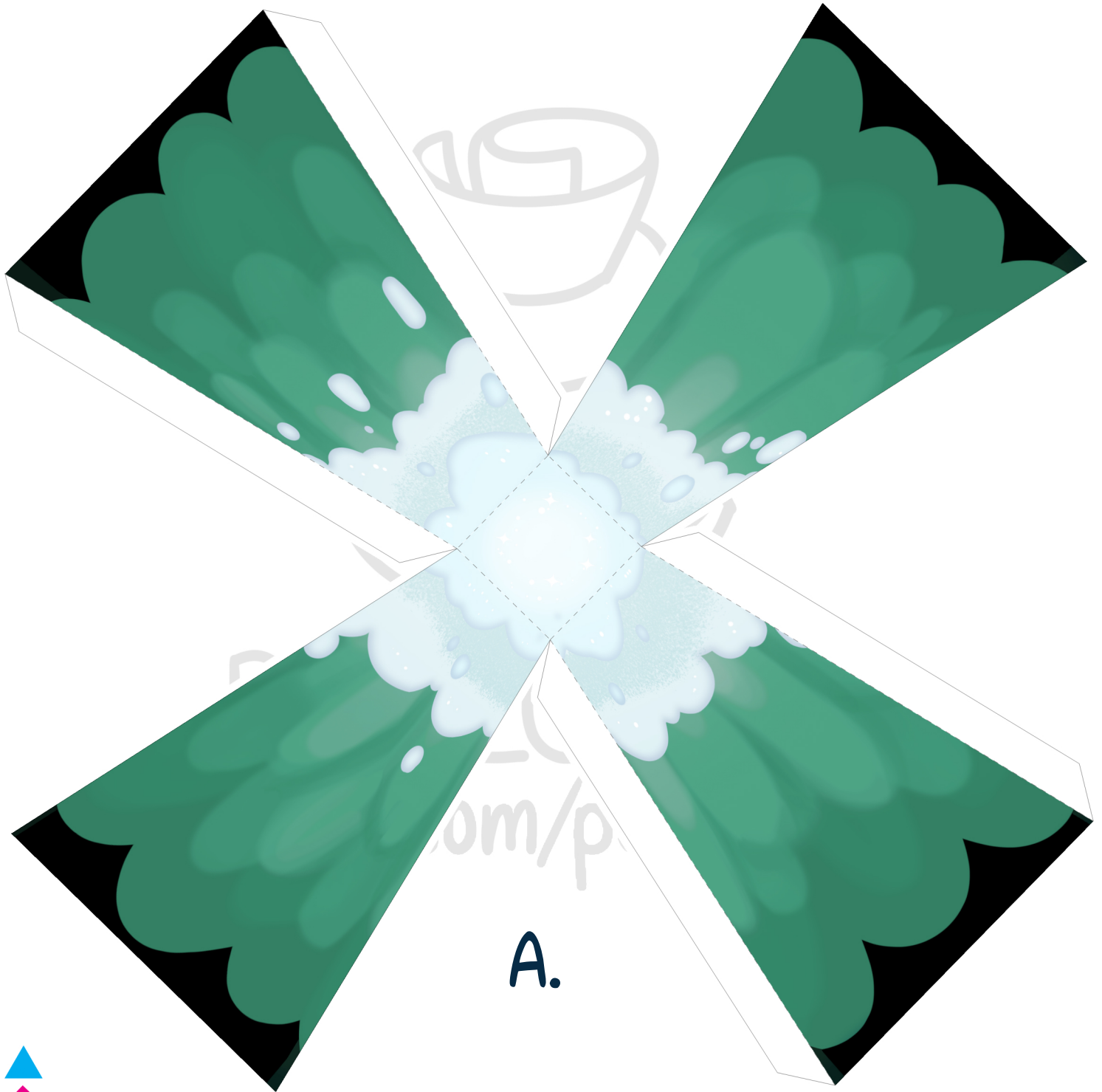
ii Build B. Paste non printed side of B to tabs of C.



iii Build A. Fit on top of the rest of the tree without glueing. You can glue it if you want.



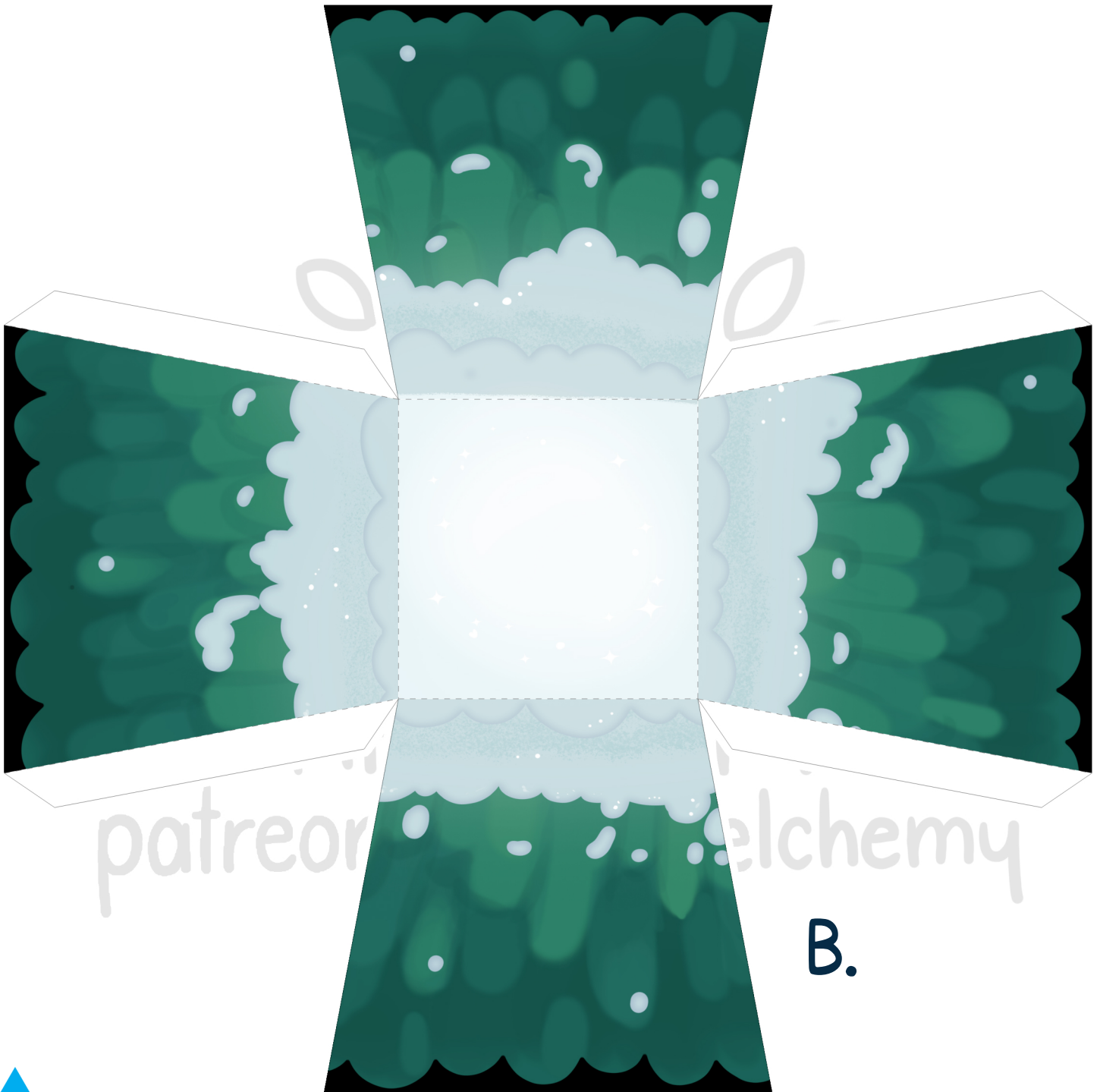
