BACKGROUND

The Temple of Protection sits in the lower market district of the city, standing out as one of the few stone buildings among predominantly timber constructions. Similar Temples have become fairly common in the poorer areas of large cities, each built by the same sect of worshippers.

They seek to become a place of calm and quiet in times of peace, but more importantly to offer a safe haven in times of chaos. The outer walls are fortified, and the clergy are as trained in defensive combat as they are in spiritual guidance. The temples are open to anyone regardless of their class or background and their doors never close.
